#### COVID Update

We are watching the daily updates of the impact of the Omicron variant of COVID-19. We have not adjusted any of our COVID-19 protocols at this time. We will continue to watch and listen for the specific guidance from the Milwaukee Health Department. We will continue with our quarantine procedures as outlined in the [Covid Protocols for Woodlands School, Inc.](#) **We will continue providing in-person instruction to all students except those that have been quarantined.**

#### COVID-19 Testing

As a part of our efforts to ensure a safe and healthy learning environment for all, we will be testing all staff for COVID-19 on Monday, Jan. 3rd during our staff day.

**We are asking all families to consider having their students tested for COVID-19 prior to their return to school on Jan. 4th. You can do this testing on your own or consider registering your students for onsite COVID-19 testing that is available at each of our campuses.** Please complete the registration for each child separately using the link below for your child to be eligible for testing. Testing occurs everyday in the morning at each campus. Once the student is registered, on any day, parents can send a written note to the school to ask that their child be tested. If the child is registered, the child will be tested.
